Re: Waiting Period of Restoration of Commutation.

We would like to bring to your attention that the Government of India established the 8th Central Pay Commission on November 3, 2025. The primary objective of the Commission is to review and recommend revisions to the salary structures, allowances, pensions, and service conditions for central government civilian and defence employees, as well as pensioners. These recommendations are scheduled to take effect from January 1, 2026.

As you may be aware, the General Insurance (Employees') Pension Scheme, 1995, is fundamentally modelled on the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules. Therefore, we kindly request you extend the benefits granted to central government pensioners to the pensioners of the general insurance sector. We urge you to consider reducing the mandatory waiting period for the restoration of commuted pension from the current 15 years.

We await your kind acknowledgement in this matter.
